PACKING TIPS ESSENTIAL FOR A GOOD CAMP EXPERIENCE

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

NOTE- MARK ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR CAMPER'S NAME.

Bedding-

Sleeping Bags or Sheets & Blanket **-PLUS-** Pillow Case. Each bed is equipped with a foam mattress and pillow. **Teens on canoe trip will need an airmattress.**

Towels & Toiletries-

Towels - One hand towel for Personal Grooming & one for beach.
Soap, Shampoo, toothpaste, tooth brush, deodorant, comb, brush.

Clothes -

Personal Clothing- Swimming Suit, Shorts, T-Shirts, Jeans, Long Pants, Socks, Durable Shoes (2), Hat, Raincoat or Poncho. Sweater & Jacket for cooler weather.

Equipment-

Insect repellent **-no sprays**, sun screen, & lip balm.

Flashlight & extra batteries. Camera and Film.

All Money is to be turned in to camp registrar upon arrival.

Medication-

Send medication in original bottles, along with dosage instructions, to camp. Your bottles to be labelled with **your name**. Your medical form should list all medications. **All medications, prescription or otherwise, must be turned in upon arrival. Failure to do so could result in your dismissal from camp.**

Do Not Bring-

I-Pods, MP-3s, Radios, Tape Players, Walkman, Cell Phones, knives, matches, food, smoking materials, drugs, alcohol, or offensive reading material.

Expensive items! The camp will not be responsible for these items.

Note: Illicit drugs brought to camp will be confiscated and proper authorities notified.

~TEEN NOTICE- Teens arrive on Monday Aug. 16. Their behaviour or lack of such will depend on the date they return home. We trust all will remain until Wednesday Aug. 25. Those showing a lack of respect to staff or not conforming to the rules of the camp will return home on Saturday Aug. 21 or before that date. Camp is a privilege not a right!
